Intro.....

The trick to playing *Buckwheat Batter* is mastering a couple of trouble spots. The first spot is in measure 7 where you must determine the best way to get to the barre chord at the 4th fret. You might consider using your pinky here on the melody string. The next spot occurs in measure 11 and again in measure 15. Here, the melody briefly moves to the middle string. At this point you should use your thumb to play this note. Remember to let each chord ring while flat-picking the other notes. In certain places, the chords require you to fret some notes. Be sure to hang on to these chorded notes also while you play.
