Intro.....

*Red Haired Boy* is not a difficult arrangement. However, the presence of a C natural in the song requires us to use the 6th fret on the bass string in both the A and B sections. Fingering suggestions are shown here to help you in moving to this point. Also, the chord built at the beginning of the B section uses the pinky on the middle string. You should immediately lay the pinky across both the middle and melody strings to help you with the note that follows at fret 4 after playing the 6 with your thumb.
