Intro.....

A hornpipe is a type of dance that has many quick steps. It is written in duple meter and has many eighth notes. The eighth notes should be played long-short, long-short etc. in a shuffling fashion with the accents placed on the longer of the two notes. While the rhythm actually looks like this it is tabbed like this in order to make the tab easier to read. Hornpipes are a lot like reels but are usually played somewhat slower because of the many dance steps associated with the tune. The hornpipes included in this collection can easily be played at 120 to 130 beats per minute. Work for an eventual tempo of 160 beats per minute.
