The quarter note - eighth note combinations ♩ ♪ used in this jig make it a "single" jig. Most jigs are composed of 2 groups of three eighth notes. ♪ ♪ ♪

Capoed on the first fret, *The Road To Lisdoonvarna* is in the key of Em. Remember that the fret numbers are the same as they would be if no capo were being used. Be careful to observe all fingering suggestions, hammer-ons, slides and pull-offs in order to play the tune up to speed. The last two lines will require more attention than the first two. Here the melody is played in the lower octave, using the middle and bass strings to play the melody notes. Also, watch the repeat signs. Both sections should be repeated.
