Intro.....

Smash The Windows is a lot of fun to play because of its many eighth notes. Upon first glance, you might think that the first section is easier to play than the second section. You will find however that the first section can be a bit tricky until you work out the hammer-ons & slides. On those occasions when the melody moves to the middle string at fret 2, use the thumb to reach that note. Pay special attention to the last line. This series of 18 eighth notes is the most difficult passage of the song. Your speed will depend on your ability to execute this particular spot. *Smash The Windows* is one of the most popular Irish jigs and has been recorded by several dulcimer players.
